



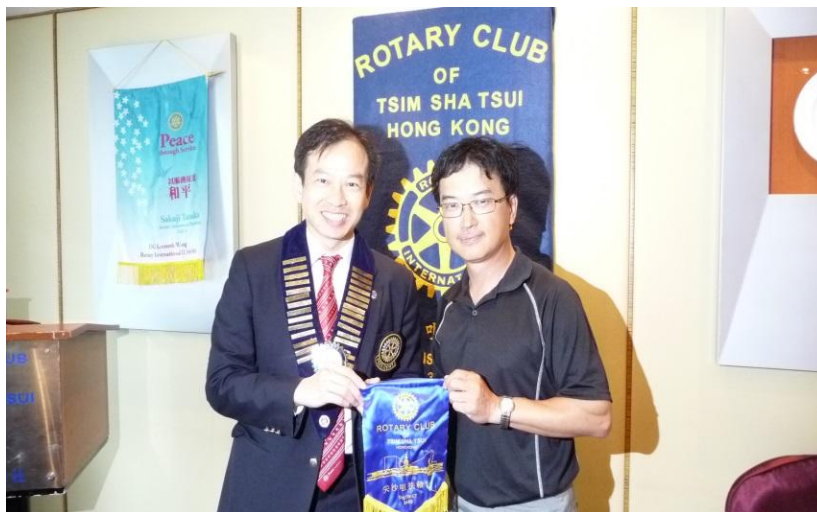

East Meets West: Importance of the role of Hong Kong in global geopark movement (27/5/2013 Rotary Club Tsimshatsui Luncheon Talk)

Our chairman, Dr Young Ng had delivered a talk at a luncheon meeting to the members of Rotary Club of Tsimshatsui on 27 May, 2013. He talked on the role of Hong Kong in the global geopark movement. He said that Hong Kong could act as a bridge between China and the western world by narrowing the gap created by their cultural differences. Such cultural differences generated misinterpretation of some geopark concepts and practices. It could lead to misunderstanding and creating both management and development problems in the geoparks of China. Dr Ng suggested ways Hong Kong could do to address these problems and helped China to develop better geoparks in the coming years. The talk entitled 'East Meets West: importance of the role of Hong Kong in global geopark movement' was very much welcomed by the Rotarians. Many questions from the floor were asked and tremendous interests were expressed.
