HONG KONG OFFSHORE WIND FARM

Association for Geoconservation, Hong Kong support the development of renewable energy, however, we oppose the wind farm project because:

- (1) HK is too small to allow project which takes away extensive land or sea areas;
- (2) Destroying the last natural paradise of Hong Kong by putting up 67 turbines in the beautiful waters of Sai Kung for an unwise project;
- (3) Ruining the invaluable, world class geological feature of Sai Kung is irresponsible to the society and our future generations;
- (4) Spending >HKD10 billion to satisfy less than 1% of HK's annual electricity consumption and at a life span of 20-25 years is economically unjustified;
- (5) Rising electricity bills for HK residents as this project will significantly raise CLP's assets which forms an excuse to increase electricity charges;
- (6) There are other better, more environmental options which have not been studied thoroughly to achieve the same or better set targets of renewable energy and reduction of CO2 emission.

The public consultation period of the EIA report will close on July 2. This is the best time to raise our voices before it is too late.
