

4th INTERNATIONAL UNESCO CONFERENCE ON GEOPARKS 2010



The 4th International UNESCO Conference on Geoparks was held in Langkawi from April 12-15, 2010. The conference aims to provide a best platform for researchers and planners to discuss the relevancy of geopark concept as the best way in pursuing holistic regional sustainable development. Participation was overwhelming with 423 delegates from 27 countries attended the conference.

AGHK's chairman Mr. Young Ng and Convener of Publicity/Public Relationship Ms. Cindy Choi attended the Conference as part of the Hong Kong geopark delegation (a total of 12 representatives) led by Mr. Edward Yau, the Secretary for Environment and Mr. Alan Wong, the Director of Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department.

Mr. Yau presented a paper on the development of geopark in Hong Kong and had impressed the audiences on the works Hong Kong had done in the past few years. Mr. Ng expounded the scientific research of Danxiashan Landform in China. His presentation greatly aroused the audiences' interest which resulted in many post presentation enquiries about Danxiashan Global Geopark.

The five days conference successfully ended with The Langkawi Declaration 2010.
