## Lai Chi Wo Geoheritage Centre

### Brief Introduction

The Geoheritage Centre in Lai Chi Wo Village in North District New Territories is set up by voluntary organizations in collaboration with local villagers and the government. The volunteers of Association for Geoconservation, Hong Kong are responsible for the planning and running of the centre. The centre aims to introduce the geological resources in Hong Kong to visitors and also raise the public awareness of geoconservation through the beautiful scenery, various geological features and old Hakka village in the region.

### Purposes

- To enhance public understanding of geological features and landforms and to raise their awareness of geoconservation
- To strengthen cultural communications and encourage local community participation
- To publicize and align with the development of geopark
- To assist the development of environmental education field trips, to provide diversified supporting services and to become a base for outdoor environmental education studies
