Brief Introduction

The Geoheritage Centre in Lai Chi Wo Village in North District New Territories is set up by voluntary organizations in collaboration with local villagers and the government. The centre aims to introduce the geological resources in Hong Kong to visitors and also raise the public awareness of geoconservation through the beautiful scenery, various geological features and old Hakka village in the region.
