

會員活動:不一樣的吉澳、鴨洲

## Members Activity: A different Kat O · Ap Chau

47 members including exco members joined the members activity: A different Kat O Ap Chau held on 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2016. It was our honour to have Professor Yim, our Honorary Advisor and Honorary Professor of Department of Earth Sciences, The University of Hong Kong, guiding us for this trip. Prof. Yim led the group to explore the unique spectacular geological features of these two places. Besides explaining about the geology of Tolo Channel, Ap Chau and Kat O as well as evidences of higher sea level during the Pleistocene Epoch (time spanned 11,000 – 1.8 million years old), he also shared the causes of global warming and his related research study with us. The participants learnt a lot from him and showed a strong interest in the topics by exchanging views. One of the most memorable moments was enjoying the rich local Hakka cuisine for lunch. After that, our Vice Chairman Ms Cindy Choi and the crew showed the participants around our Kat O Geo Heritage Centre and introduced them the local culture. On the return journey, the interesting games led by our Activities Leaders – Ms Gladys Leung and Ms Hayley Chan not only brought laughter but enabled the attendants to understand more about our mother earth.
