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What is the real image of Hong Kong?

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Due to its small area, it is extremely difficult to promote environmental conservation in Hong Kong. Current conservation focuses mainly on the biological components of our environment. Very little attention has been paid to rocks and landscapes. In fact, these physical components deserve similar, if not better, protection than their biological counterparts. It takes several millions, tens or hundreds of million years to form a piece of rock or a mountain. If it is destroyed, it is practically impossible for us to see its recovery and we will perpetually lose the natural landmark.

To most residents and visitors, Hong Kong is absolutely a concrete jungle. It is a genuine metropolis. Perhaps the metallic silvery grey IFC, HSBC or Bank of China buildings obviously form our current image. The good old granite blocks of Hong Kong and Shanghai Bank and the Bank of China buildings, however, occasionally pop up in our mind. Weren't they representing us sometime ago? What is happened to them right now? What is the real image of Hong Kong? Once we turn around and stare at the Lion Rock, we suddenly realize that rocks and landscapes are the ones who really grow up with us, experiencing with us the ups and downs of our society and accompanying us at all times to face adversities. They truly represent not only you and me, but also the overall image of all Hong Kong people. They are the everlasting face and spirit of Hong Kong.
